These courses include Sports Coaching in Cardiff, Fine Art at UCA London, International Environmental Science in Nottingham and International Relations in London. The other three students chose to study further Level 3 qualifications in order to pursue their ambitions and are all enrolled in FE colleges following their return to the UK.

We are very proud of the focus and effort put in by all these students and the guidance and support they have received from staff at King Richard School. The diverse nature of the next steps for these students demonstrates that, no matter where your ambitions lie, King Richard Sixth Form will prepare you for the future you choose and allow you the opportunity to continue to grow and improve as a learner and a person.

Amazing GCSE Results Celebrated at King Richard School!

83% A*-C grades including English and Maths were achieved by our students, up from 53% last year, a momentous increase! The government bench mark of A*-C grades including English and Maths has now been replaced with a 'Progress 8 score' that we will have confirmed later in the term, however we estimate that our overall score will be +5 (the national average being 0) which is an exceptionally high score. 29% of students achieved 3 or more A/A* grades which is a fantastic outcome.
