"The Headmaster, Mr G. E. Bettsworth, then gave his second annual report, in which he reviewed briefly the school's activities of the past year. He expressed his gratification at the maintenance of sound standards in the successes achieved in the London G.C.E. and R.S.A. examinations, and his confidence in the academic prospects for 1964, particularly in view of the increasing numbers in the Fifth and Sixth Forms.

Next year will see the introduction for the majority of children of courses based on the C.S.E. syllabus with its realistic and practical approach. We intend to integrate more closely the work done in the various subjects. We aim at a less academic and less segregated approach the teaching of individual subjects, while safeguarding the excellence of the standards aimed at by the truly academic."
