Re: Proposed change to the MFL curriculum from September 2018

As you know, currently at KRS all KS3 pupils study French and German but statistics show that the most widely-taught foreign languages in UK secondary schools are French and Spanish. In fact, according to a BBC report this week, "Long-term trends suggest that Spanish is surging in popularity and is likely to overtake French as the main modern language taught in secondary schools, within a decade."

In order to ease transition for our pupils to and from the UK and due to a change in staffing at KRS next year, we are considering a change to the MFL curriculum. This would mean that pupils who are in Years 7, 8 & 9 in September 2018 would no longer study French and German; instead, they would learn French and Spanish, with a focus on preparing them for the GCSE and A-Level courses in these languages, for those who wish to study a language in Key Stages 4 and 5. Please note that the pupils who are currently in Years 9 & 10 and who have chosen to study German as one of their option subjects will still be able to complete the GCSE German course here at KRS.
