

Leavers Letter -

Dear Parent / Guardian,

This letter is hoping to outline arrangements for all leavers; those in Y13 ending their 6th form qualifications, those in Y11 ending their KS4 qualifications, and those leaving us as part of the Battalion move.

Y13:

As we approach the completion of coursework and final assessments this term some students will have the opportunity to move towards a reduced timetable. This will mean students will only need to attend school for priority lessons in subjects where work/units are outstanding and/or where assessments still need to be completed. Some courses still have remaining parts of the specification to be taught and so this is of course of utmost importance.

Reduced timetables will need to be agreed with Mrs Barrow and will only be permitted once official sign off from the course has been sanctioned by class teachers and Mr Sproson. We hope the reduced time in school will give year 13 students the opportunity to prepare for the next phase of their educational journeys.

We will also hold an official leavers assembly on May 20th after school (2 - 3pm). On the same day students are also invited for an informal farewell meal at 7pm at Masalas - pending restrictions. **The official leaving day for Year 13s will be May 28th.** This will enable all courses to have time to complete their specifications and for all assessments to be completed and moderated. If students do complete their studies with us prior to this date early leave may be granted. In this case an official 'signing out' form must be completed with a final sign off by the Headteacher before students can cease to follow their timetables.

Y11:

Students are entering the last few weeks of their formal lessons of KS4 which are ending with exam board tests in the majority of subjects. These tests are scheduled to be completed for all students by 11th June. If any students are finished before then their lessons will continue to run as normal until this date as the specifications are fully finished and evidence finalised.

The final day for all Y11's is therefore the 11th June 2021.

Students then have 2 options:

- a) Finish schooling at KRS and are off rolled from our register. They are then free to move with family to new locations or prepare in their own way for their next steps.
- b) return to school between 20th - 24th June to begin transition work into their KS5 studies. Students will create an agreed timetable with Mrs Barrow (Head of 6th Form) and work on a mixture of online activities relating to subject choices for KS5, online work experience, volunteering opportunities and challenges as well as the potential of some face-to-face lessons if this works on the timetable. This may be a full time or part time arrangement of hours across a week.

The Y11 have their leaving Meal / Party planned to be at the Watersports Beach Bar on 11th June 18:30 – 21:30 – more details of time and logistics to follow later in the month.

All other year group leavers this academic year:

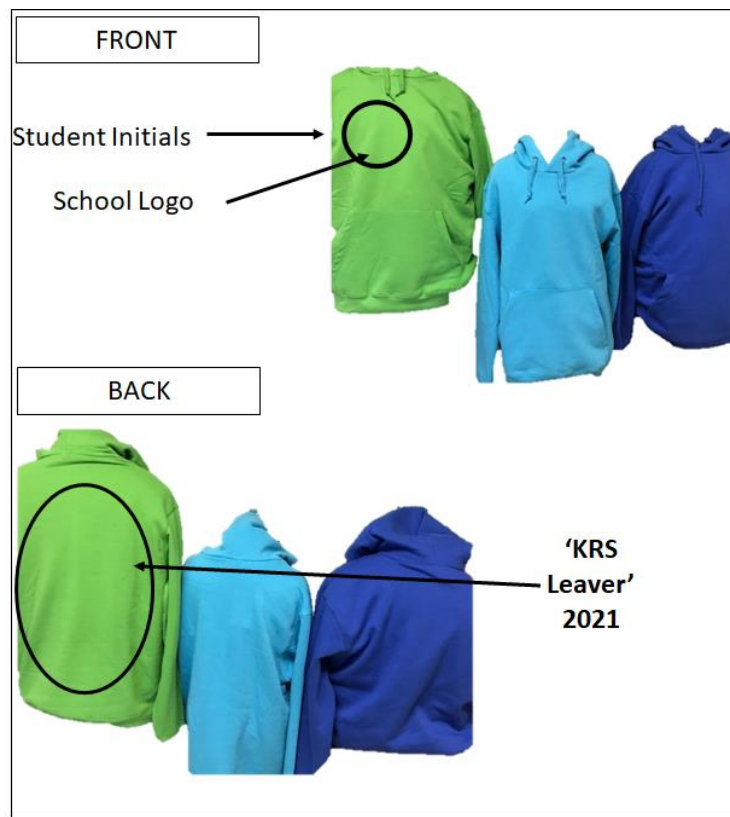

The Battalion leavers not in Y11 or Y13 will have an in school leaving event to celebrate their time at KRS as part of the last Day in school on 20th July.

Leavers Hoodies:

The last day of term for students not in Y11 or 13 is 20th July 2021, unless you have been posted earlier and have contacted school to make them aware to support your child's transition.

We would like to offer the opportunity to all leavers to buy 'leavers hoodies'. These will be at the school subsidised cost of 15 Euro's.
